Call for Nominations: President Elect

With the recent resignation of former President David Tout, President-Elect Tim Beatty has assumed to office of President. The Bylaws state that vacancies for board-at-large, secretary and treasurer will be filled by appointment of the Board. A vacancy in the office of President is filled by the President-elect as stated below:

Article 4 Section 3:

The President-Elect shall assume the duties of the President in the latter's absence. In the event the Presidency is vacated, he/she shall assume the office. The President-Elect shall also act as a member of the Bylaws Committee. After serving one term of office as President-Elect, he/she shall serve as President for one term of office.

The board is now calling for a special election to fill the remaining term for the President-elect. The person elected will become President on July 1, 2009. President Beatty will then become the Past-President.

The Nominating Committee is now calling for nominations for candidates for the Office of President-Elect. We will accept nominations until August 30, 2009. Ballots will be distributed as soon as possible thereafter and must be returned within 30 days of distribution.

To be eligible to run for the office of President-elect, candidates must be members in good standing of ADARA. They need to understand that if elected they will assume the Presidency in 2009.
